Halloween Costumes:

Students and staff are encouraged to wear costumes or black and orange on Tuesday, October 31st to celebrate Halloween and to show their school spirit.

Reminder message from the District:

The District does not have an official policy regarding Halloween costumes, instead we ask that everyone be respectful and mindful of others by following the guidelines below.

- 1. Students must be identifiable and visible to ensure safety.
- 2. Masks are not permitted. Face makeup is permitted provided the student is still identifiable.
- 3. Scary clowns are not permitted.
- 4. Costumes that depict violence, alcohol or drugs are not appropriate.
- 5. Fake weapons are not permitted.
- 6. Costumes that are provocative, sexual in nature or employ questionable props are not permitted.
- 7. Costumes should not hinder a student's ability to travel through the school and outdoor space safely.

Please remember that costumes, even with good intent, may make others feel scared, upset, insulted or humiliated. Below are two guiding questions that may help determine appropriateness of costumes for school.

- 1. Does the costume depict or perpetuate a stereotype or stigma associated with a particular race, culture, religion or gender?
- 2. Would the costume be considered offensive to a particular race, culture, religion or gender?
